Class Rules

Tardies: You are tardy if you are not in the classroom preparing to learn.

1st tardy- Warning and teacher sends a note to parents

2nd tardy- After school detention in the teacher's classroom

3rd tardy- Sent to the principal's office and assigned one day of detention

4th tardy- Sent to the principal's office and assigned one day of SDC

Procedures

1. Write your name, the date, and the period for each assignment in the upper right corner of the first page.
2. Write the assignment title on the top line of the front of the paper.
3. Make sure that your work is legible, meaning I can read it without difficulties.
4. Bring all homework assignments to class, completed and ready to turn in on the day each are due.
5. Class is dismissed by the teacher, not by the bell. Do not get out of your seat to leave until instructed by the teacher.

Homework: Most homework assignments are started in class and are assigned to be finished before the next class meeting or by the assigned date.

Make up work: I follow the district's makeup policy.

Test Make-Up Policy: The test must be scheduled to be taken before or after school and must be completed within one week from the test date.

Bring your own device: The use of your own technological device is for educational purposes only. I will decide when the device can be used in my class. Failure to adhere to this rule will result in the loss of privilege to use the device in my class.

Netbook Usage: Netbooks are used often in class. Students are to work on my assignments only. Students are not to play games, browse the internet, or change any computer setting. Failure to adhere to this rule will result in the loss of privilege to use the netbooks in my class. If students break a netbook internally or externally, they are responsible for paying the cost of the netbook.
